Do's

- DO use the right glove for proper protection. There can be many hazards for your hands, whether from chemicals, cuts or burns.
- ✓ DO provide leadership. If staff do not see managers utilizing proper glove protection, they will be less inclined to observe glove safety procedures themselves.
- ✓ DO ensure that you provide your staff with proper training on when to use safety gloves and what types of gloves are required. Make wearing gloves a habit.

Don'ts

- X DON'T use a glove that is ripped or torn. Damaged gloves are less able to provide proper hand protection.
- DON'T minimize the importance of glove safety. Safety should always be prioritized in the workplace, especially around toxic chemicals or other hazards.
